



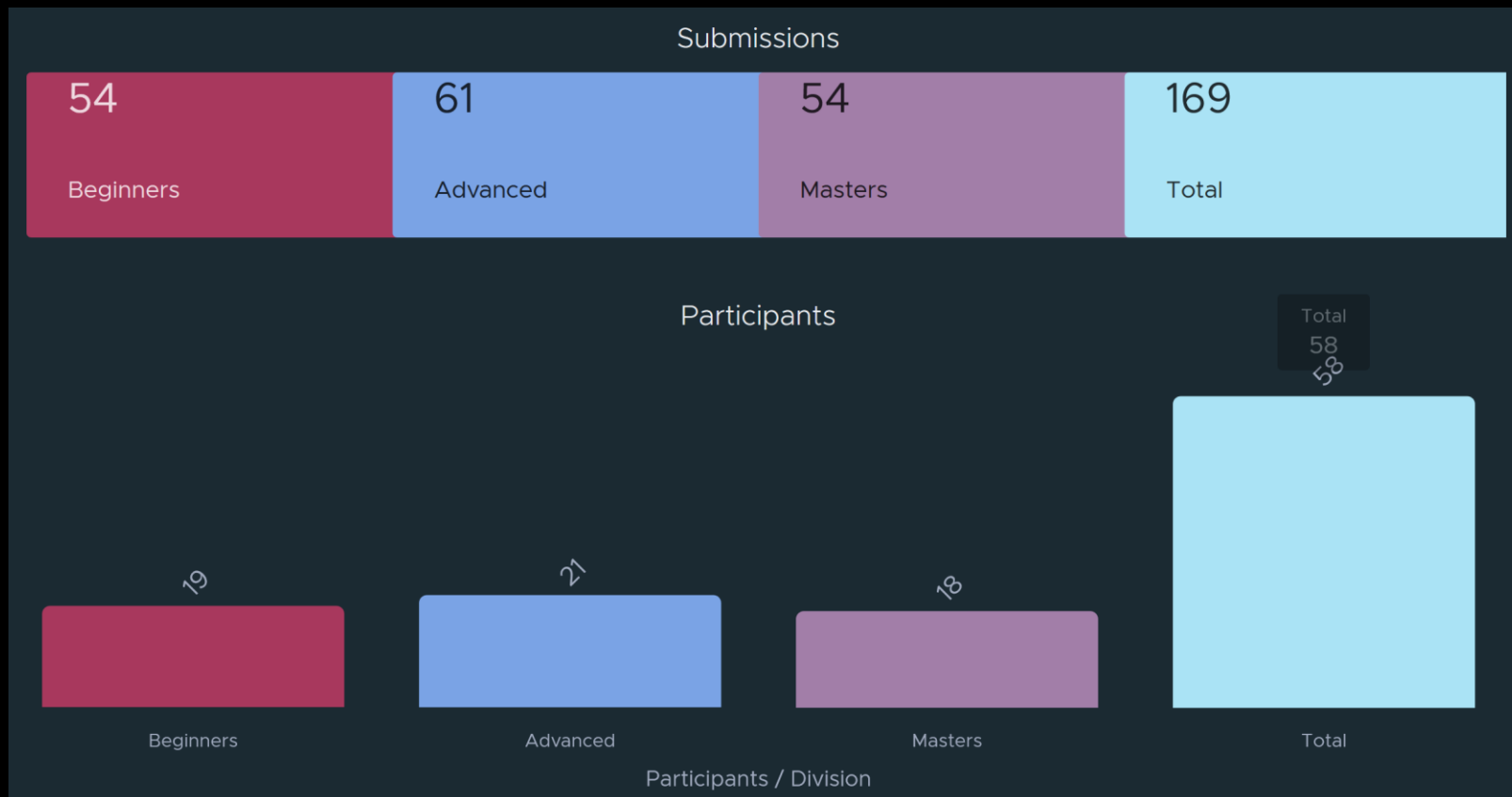

# OBSERVATIONS

- Image sizing – thankfully no longer an issue with sincere appreciation to David Hillock for his revamping of the website submission process
- Ineligible Subject matter – 2% of submissions
  - NO non-domesticated animals (insects, reptiles, birds, fish, mammals, etc.)
- Not photorealistic due to nature of digital manipulation – 2% of submissions
  - Split-mirror images; abstract creative manipulations; reality-defying images
  - Final determination by Competition Chairs

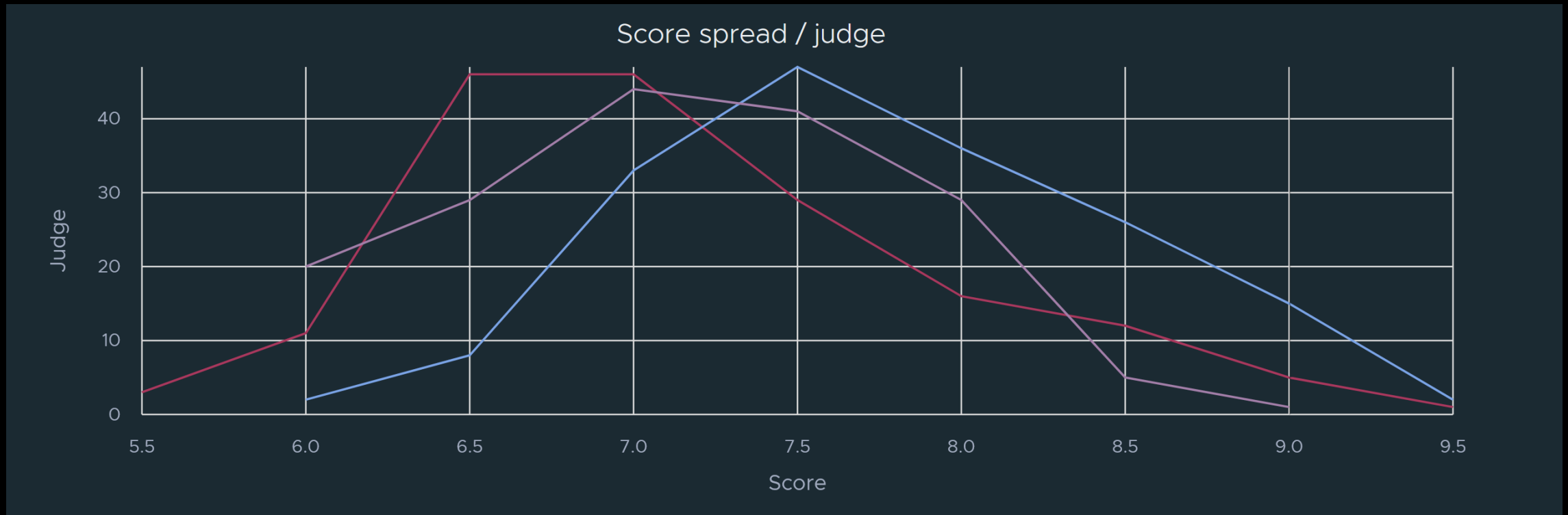
# JUDGING STATISTICS

- Lowest aggregate score: 18.5 (1 image)
- Highest aggregate score: 26.0 (2 images)
- Average aggregate scores:
  - Beginners 21.4
  - Advanced 21.8
  - Masters 22.9
- Minimum score to win an award:
  - Beginners 24.0
  - Advanced 23.5
  - Masters 25.0

# JUDGING STATISTICS

- Scoring consistency on 169 images judged
  - $\geq 1.5$  point difference: 37% (63 images)
  - $\geq 2.0$  point difference: 17% (28 images)
  - $\geq 2.5$  point difference: 5% (8 images)
- No comments were requested of judges on differences of  $\geq 2$  points due to online nature of judging and time constraints on follow-up conference call given 28 images.

# OVERALL POINT DISTRIBUTION BY JUDGE

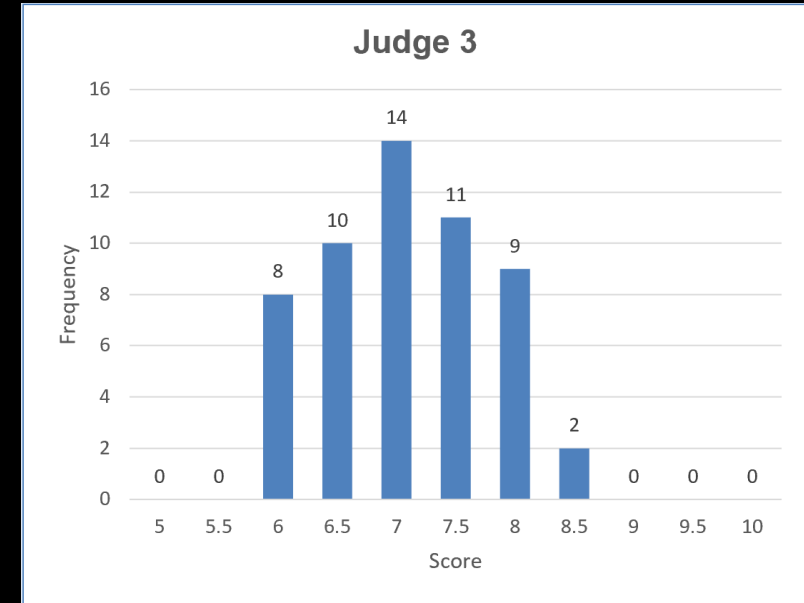
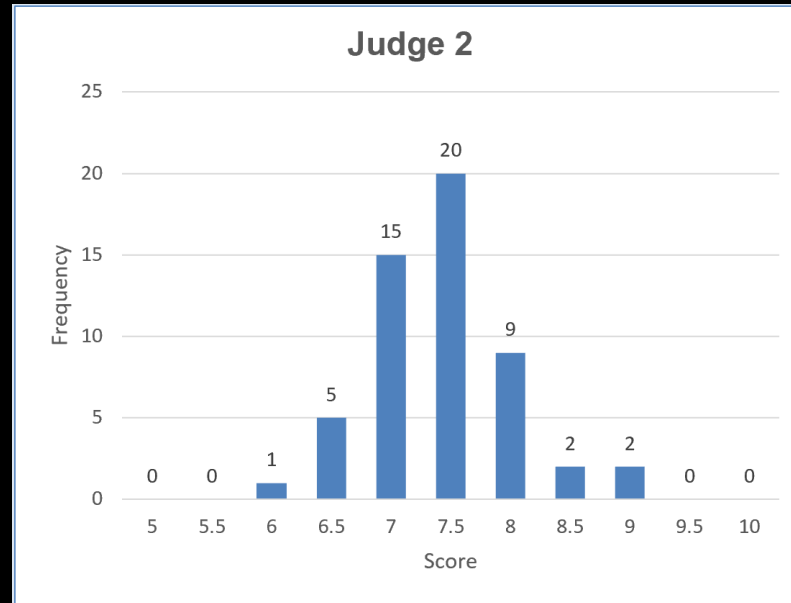
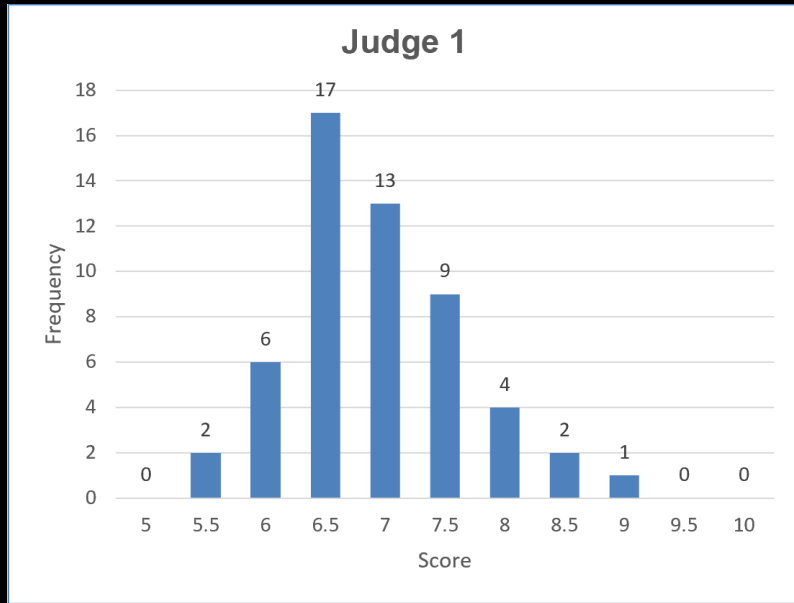

# BEGINNERS POINT DISTRIBUTION BY JUDGE

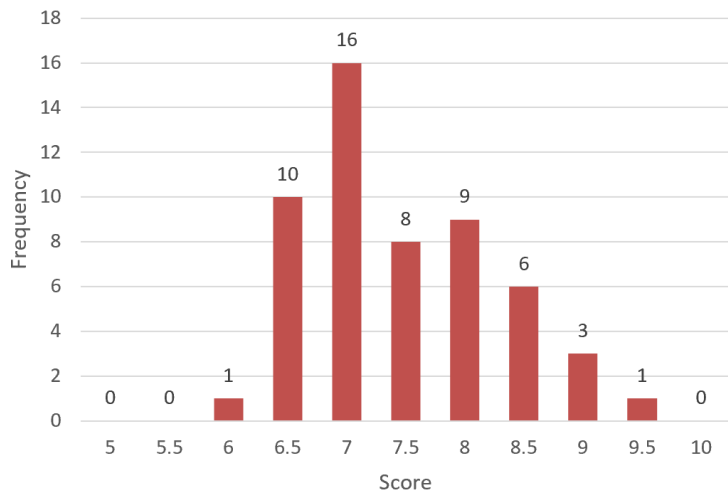


# ADVANCED POINT DISTRIBUTION BY JUDGE

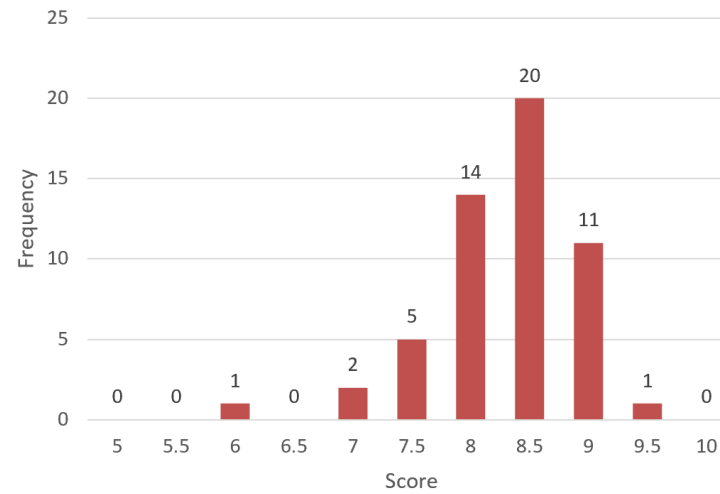

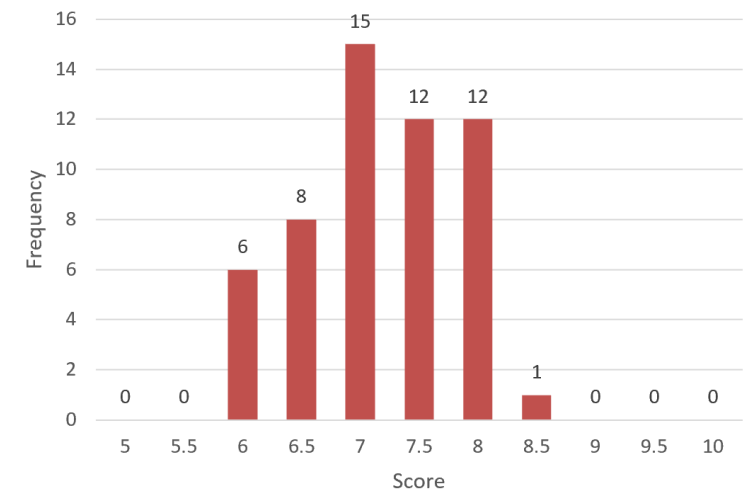

# PICTORIAL #2 DEADLINE

- Monday, November 15<sup>th</sup> @ midnight
- Please remember:
  - No non-domesticated animals as subject matter
  - No duplicate submissions (i.e., images ever before entered into a monthly Pictorial Competition)
  - Maintain photorealistic appearance – Competition Chairs determination is final

# PICTORIAL # 3 DEADLINE

- Monday, February 21<sup>st</sup> @ midnight submission deadline
- MONOCHROME images only are eligible for Pictorial #3
  - Using simple filters before converting to greyscale can leave traces of different hues in the processed image
  - Monochrome is only one colour (hue) with different tones or shades of that colour. Duotone involves two colours and is not monochrome
  - Examples of monochrome:
    - Black & White – shades of neutral grey
    - Sepia – shades of a redish-brown hue
    - Cyan – shades of – just guessed it – cyan hue
