 - The (substantially) same image may be entered into <u>only one</u> Monthly competition <u>per Club year</u> – does not apply to images within Audio Visual competitions or series of images within Assigned Topics
 - The (substantially) same image entered into a specific Monthly category (e.g., Pictorial) competition may <u>never again</u> be entered into that <u>same specific</u> <u>Monthly category competition</u>, regardless of Club year
- SPECIFIC RULE FOR **MONTHLY** PICTORIAL COMPETITIONS
 - Subject matter <u>may not</u> consist of non-domesticated animals (e.g., birds, insects, fish, reptiles, amphibians, wildlife in the zoo or in the wild)

- Maximum of three images, or series of images, per maker
- No previous award-winning images are eligible

OPEN-DIVISION (YEAR-END) PICTORIAL COMPETITIONS

- Bohdan Switajlo competition
- Urban Landscape as subject matter
 - "Must include an expansive area (e.g., two or more streets) whose urban setting is immediately evident"
 - "Images should attempt to reflect some of the city's character"
- Maximum of three images per maker
- [last year only 40 images from 16 makers]

OPEN-DIVISION (YEAR-END) PICTORIAL COMPETITIONS

- 3M competition
- Human Portrait or Character Study as subject matter
- Maximum of three images per maker
- [last year only 38 images from 14 makers]

OPEN-DIVISION (YEAR-END) PICTORIAL COMPETITIONS

- Charles Miller Memorial competition
- Series of images from Club organized Ontario outings over the past 12 months
- Minimum of five, maximum of eight images per series
- Maximum of three series of images per maker
- No titles or commentary on images is permitted
- [last year only 11 series from 7 makers]


