# Frank Pogue Trophy

**For TCC Beginner showing most progress in all forms of photography during club year**

Frank Pogue joined the club in 1942 and was an active member serving as director, member of the board and program director. He was salon director for 16 years. He donated the trophy to the club in 1952 to encourage and reward those beginners who competed. When he died in 1964, the club had the trophy re-inscribed and named it after him. Over the years the trophy description was expanded to include **“outstanding interest and participation in club activities.”**



# Buckley Trophy

## For the most winning points in the Beginners Division

This trophy was donated in 1975 by Dorothy and Syd Buckley (past president 1979-81) who wished to encourage beginners in colour pictorial and nature photography. It was designed by Dorothy, who wanted something free-form and natural. A suitable piece of driftwood they found at Fahrquar Lake was attached to a base made of a piece of maple from an old tree in the Buckleys' garden. A trophy shop added the figure of the photographer. It was originally awarded for Pictorial and Nature Slides and then for digital Projected Images and Nature Images. Commencing in 2012 it is awarded for the most winning images in the Beginners Division

# Honours Trophy

## **For the most winning Honour Points in the Advanced Division**

Donated in 1964 by John J. Lawson A.R.P.S. A.P.S.A. John Lawson was a top print pictorialist, and writer of many articles on technical and scientific processes in printmaking. This trophy was originally awarded for the most print HM's during the season, changed in 2008 to Monochrome OR Colour Prints and in 2010 to Monochrome AND Colour Prints. Commencing in 2012 it is awarded for the most winning images in the Advanced Division.

## For the most winning Honour Points in the Masters Division

This trophy was presented to the club by Mr. Walter A. Carveth, President of Walter A. Carveth Ltd., Canadian distributors of Leica cameras, to stimulate the art of photography. It was originally awarded for "outstanding photographic achievement" but the Board ceased awarding it in 1976. In 2012 it was reinstated to be awarded for the most winning images in the Masters Division.
