Website Personal Profile Policy

The Toronto Camera Club is a social club, and the purpose of the Website Personal Profiles is to help members connect and get to know each other better.

Having a Personal Profile is optional, and should you decide to have one, most of the information contained in the profile is also optional – you are not required to provide information in every profile field.

Here are the current profile fields that are available. All fields are optional, except for the Profile Headshot.

- Email Address
- Telephone Number
- Profile Headshot (**Required**)
- Publish Your Profile (Yes, No)
- Personal Background
- Photography Interest
- What's in my Camera Bag
- Social Media Links
- Current TCC Volunteer Roles

Remember that a successful profile is unique to you, it outlines your photographic interests, how you chose the contents of your camera bag with anecdotes that illuminate your style as a photographer. Above all, a profile should be personal not political, perhaps a personal revelation but never a rant. A personal profile should not include comments on current events, political or religious statements, or any other topics unrelated to photography and the club.

A personal profile must include a headshot that is a realistic representation of your current self. When a Member sees your headshot, they should be able to recognize you in the club.

If a Member uploads a headshot that does not conform to the above requirements or the profile includes prohibited content, the Website Chair will unpublish the profile and ask that the profile be updated.

If a Member disagrees with the Website Chair's assessment, they can appeal to the Club Executive by writing an email to ExecutiveOfficers@TorontoCameraClub.com and copying WebsiteChair@TorontoCameraClub.com.

Privacy: Your personal profile is published in the Members-only section of the website. Members are requested to respect each other's privacy by not sharing any information outside of the Club. However, since this cannot be fully controlled, the Toronto Camera Club cannot be held responsible for any breaches.
